- Review library policies, programming, and activities to make sure the adhere to restorative justice practices
- Actively promoting diversity initiatives in library locations and supporting those customers and staff who participate in such activities.
- Continually review material, training, and other research to make certain that APL remains on the cutting edge of diversity initiatives.
